Kitsap Public Facilities District Resolution 05-2006

A RESOLUTION establishing a Public Meeting and Community Service Appreciation Expenses Policy as a guideline for the payment of necessary expenses for meals and refreshments at certain meetings of the KPFD.

WHEREAS, the KPFD ordinarily conducts its business at open public meetings scheduled at 6:30 p.m.;

WHEREAS, the KPFD upon occasion is required to conduct its business at open public meetings that must be scheduled at meal times or for an extended duration;

WHEREAS, the KPFD upon occasion convenes an open public meeting with the stated purpose of recognizing and showing appreciation of board members upon their retirement from KPFD service or to acknowledge special volunteer service to the KPFD by a member of public as a way of providing public promotion of the KPFD and mission;

WHEREAS, the KPFD does not use KPFD funds for recognition of employees' retirement or special service to the KPFD; and,

WHEREAS, the KPFD wishes to establish a policy for the payment of the expense of meals and refreshments under these circumstances.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors may, from time to time in its sole discretion pay expenses for meals or refreshments at open, public meetings, that in no event include alcoholic beverages, in accord with the Public Meetings and Community Service Appreciation Expenses Policy that is attached to this resolution.
